Competitive Open (Entries limited to 12 teams)

This grade would be suitable for players with club level or top Social A Grade experience. Mixed teams welcomed but this is not a requirement.

Social A Grade (Entries limited to 24 teams or at the organisers discretion may be a grade of 12 depending on the mix of entries received) This grade would be suitable for very competent social players.

Mixed teams welcomed but not a requirement.

Social B Grade (Entries limited to 12 teams or at the organisers discretion may be a grade of 24 depending on the mix of entries received) This grade is suitable for Social Players of mixed ability.

IMPORTANT NOTES

- Masters Teams 40+ masters teams. All players in the team must be 40+ on the date of the tournament start. There will be a prize for the top placed 40+ team in each grade subject to their being 2 or more 40+ teams in the grade)
- Grade Selection If you are unsure about your team's grade, please don't hesitate to get in touch with us.



- **Player numbers Teams should carry at least 8 players.** This is a demanding tournament. You can expect to play 6-8 games in the space of less than 48 hours. There will also be an expectation that your team will do 4-5 duties (depending on draw).
- **Playing across teams** It is our expectation that players **do not** play for more than one team. If there are any changes to teams in the case of an emergency this should be cleared with the organisers to avoid any disputes. In the spirit of the tournament, we would ask that you abide by this to avoid problems.
- **Playing Balls & Whistles** All players who may be refereeing must have their own whistles. This is now commonsense with various viruses always circulating through the community. Please get yourselves whistles now if you don't already have one. It would be appreciated if you could please supply a match ball of reasonable quality. A Molten V5M4500 or better would be acceptable.
- Invoices: Will be issued within 14 days of receiving entry.
- Entry Fees:\$250 per team payable by Friday 25 October.Please reference your team's name with the entry.
- **Entries Close:** Thursday 24 October or when capacity is reached. Please note that in the past this tournament has reached capacity within 14 days of the entries being circulated.
